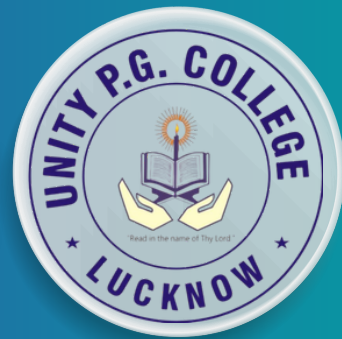

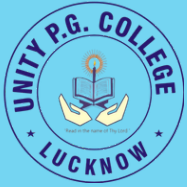
About the Conference

Call For Abstract (s)

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- The Conference is open for Students, Academicians and Research Scholars.
- The submissions must reach before the deadline, and no requests will be entertained beyond that.
- At least one of the author must be registered for the conference.
- The abstract must be between 150 - 250 words, along with 3-5 keywords.

Guidelines for Poster/ Oral Presentation

Each presenter will be allotted:

- 03 minutes for presentation.
- 02 minutes for discussion and questions.
- Presenters are advised to adhere to the time limit strictly.

Presentation Format

- Presentations must be prepared in PowerPoint (PPT/PPTX) or PDF format.
- The Poster Presentation will be conducted exclusively in virtual mode.
- Participants are required to prepare their poster in a single slide using Microsoft PowerPoint.
- No TA/DA or accommodation will be provided.
- Participants attending the conference in online mode will receive an e-certificate, whereas participants attending in physical mode will be awarded a hard copy certificate.

Guidelines for Full Paper Submission

Note: Authors whose abstracts are accepted will be invited to submit the full paper for presentation and publication consideration.

- The title of the manuscript must be clear, concise, and aligned with the overall conference theme.
- The official language of the conference and presentations is English.
- The manuscript should be between 3,500–5,000 words (excluding abstract and footnotes).

The first page must clearly mention:

- Title of the Manuscript
- Name(s) of the Author(s)
- Designation(s)
- Name of the Institution/University/Organization
- Email Address(es)
- Contact Number(s)

Additional Guidelines

- The Paper must have the following heads: Background, Objectives, Methodology, Results and Conclusion.
- The submission must be the original work of the author(s).
- The paper must not have been published or submitted elsewhere.
- Plagiarism must be less than 10%.
- The use of AI-generated content is strictly prohibited.
- References must follow APA style. (7th Edition)
- Co-authorship is permitted for up to two co-author in addition to the main author.

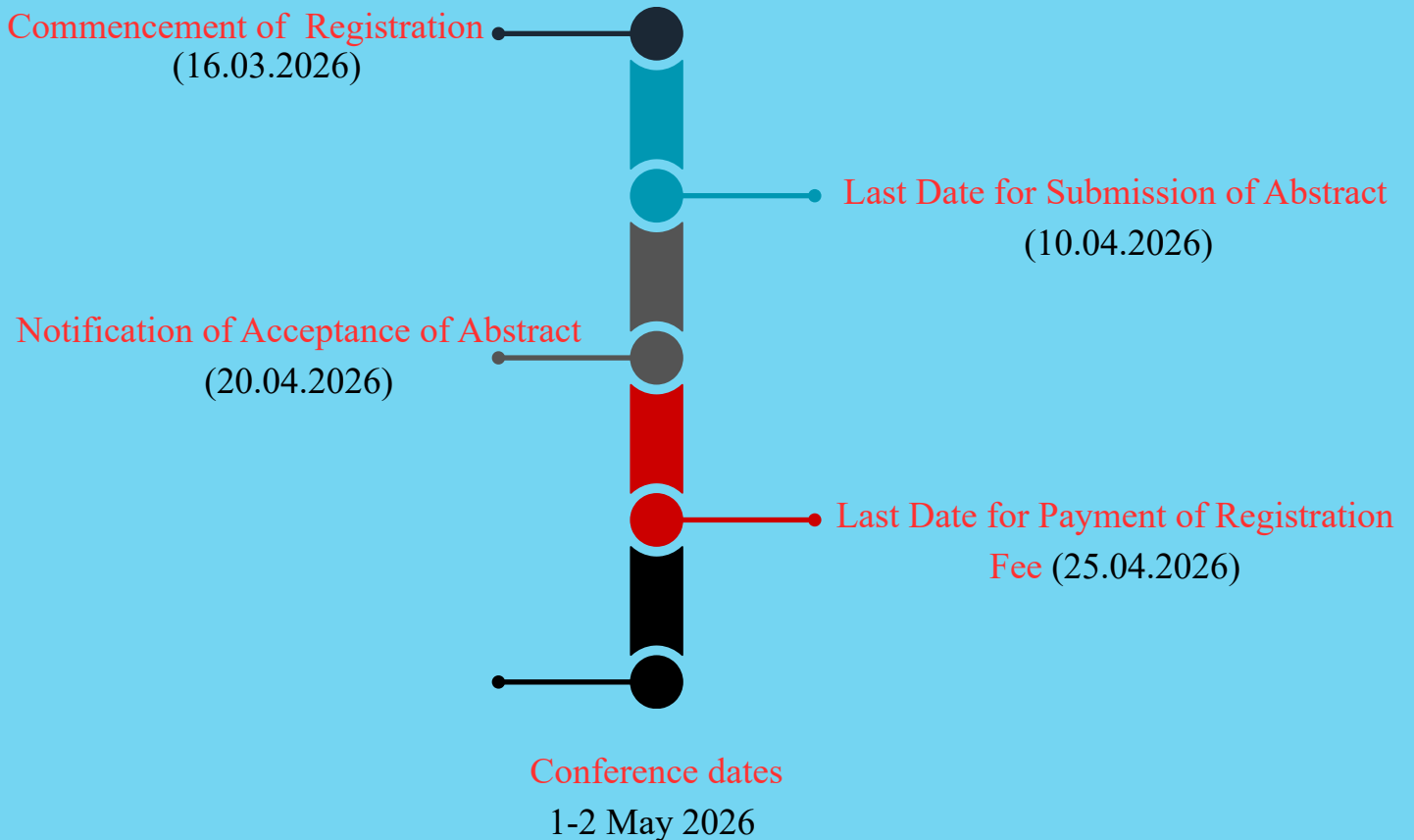
Formatting Requirements for Abstract & Full Paper

- File format: Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt Headings 14 pt.
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Alignment: Justified
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- Footnotes: 10 pt font, single line spacing, justified alignment
- No page borders

Eligibility for Awards

- Attach a cover letter mentioning the nature of the research, its applicability, relevance and justification for consideration for the award
